Tell them to use SPECIFIC ADJECTIVES and CONCRETE EXAMPLES as they discuss your unique qualities. Since many of the scholarships are awarded based upon community service activities, one of your recommendations should be from a person who knows you in this capacity and can address your character, work ethic etc.
